

YOUR JOURNEY TO JESUS Bible Study Notes

Numbers 16: Rebellion Against Moses and Aaron

Tonight we begin our study of Numbers Chapter 16. In this chapter we will read and discuss how Korah, Dathan, Abiram, and On, rose in rebellion against Moses and Aaron; along with some of the children of Israel. The topics covered in this chapter will include:

- The Rebellion Against Moses and Aaron (verses 1-19)
- The Judgment On the Rebels (verses 20-35)
- The Atonement for the Rebellion (verses 1 19), and
- The Complaints of the People (verses 1-19)

As we begin to dig deeper into this chapter, we will become familiar with these men, who they were, and what became of them.

- <u>Korah</u> was the son of Izhar, who was the son of Kohath. Kohath was the son of Levi, one of the 12 sons of Jacob (<u>Exodus 6:16-21</u>).
- <u>Dathan</u> and <u>Abiram</u> were the sons of Eliab. Eliab was of the tribe of Judah, and was the eldest son of Jesse (<u>1 Chronicles 2:13-15</u>; <u>Numbers 26:5-11</u>; <u>1 Chronicles 5:1-3</u>) and thus the eldest brother of King David.
- On was the son of Peleth, who was the son of Jonathan. Jonathan was the son of Saul (Numbers 16:1-2; 1 Samuel 9:1-2; 1 Chronicles 2:32-33; 1 Chronicles 10:1-2)

We Should Avoid Those Who Bring Division and Strife

- Titus 3:9-11 (Reject a division man)
- Romans 16:17-20 (Avoid divisive people)
- <u>1 Corinthians1:10</u> (Let there be no division between us)
- Proverbs 6:12-19 (The wicked man)
- Jude 1:4-6 (Those who do not believe)
- <u>Job 24:13-17</u> (Those who rebel against the light)
- Psalm 5:4-12 (God hates the workers of iniquity)
