Bible Study Notes

Revelation 10: The Mighty Angel with the Little Book

Good evening, welcome to our Tuesday Night Bible Study. Tonight, we begin our study of Revelation 10. In this chapter John sees a mighty angel coming down from heaven, he provided a description of this angel and revealed the message given to him by the angel; “no further delays would occur before the earth feels the terrifying power of God's anger, wrath, and judgment on the wicked and the ungodly ([Romans 1:18-32](#); [1 Peter 4:7-19](#)).

After the angel finished speaking with John; John was instructed, by the voice he heard from heaven, to take the little book from the angel's hand and eat it; but this isn't the first time that an angel with great authority is mentioned in scripture ([Revelation 18:1-3](#); [Revelation 7:1-3](#); [Revelation 8:1-6](#)). This is also not the first time prophecy was given and the hearer was told to either close the book/scroll or to eat it ([Daniel 12:1-13](#); [Ezekiel 3:1-11](#)). The topics we will be covering include:

- The Mighty Angel with the Little Book (verses 1-4)
- The angel standing on the sea and on the land (5-7)
- John Eats the Little Book (verse 8-11)

The gospel has been candy coated to make those who claim to know and follow Christ feel comfortable in their fallen state ([2 Timothy 3:1-9,12-17](#)). In this study we will be reading and discussing in great detail the things that many people shy away from; the truth of God's Word as it is written.

The watchmen have gone forth, the message is clear, and the call is final; in these times we are in, do not harden your heart; this is no time for doubt or fear ([Matthew 28:18-20](#); [2 Timothy 4:2-5](#); [Ezekiel 33:1-11](#); [Hebrews 3:7-11](#); [1 Corinthians 16:13](#)).

Visions of the Throne Room

- [Ezekiel 1:26-28](#) (And above the firmament over their heads was the likeness of a throne, in appearance like a sapphire stone; on the likeness of the throne was a likeness with the appearance of a man high above it)

- [Revelation 4:1-5](#) (And He who sat there was like a jasper and a sardius stone in appearance; and there was a rainbow around the throne, in appearance like an emerald)
- [Daniel 7:9-10,13-14](#) (His garment was white as snow, and the hair of His head was like pure wool. His throne was a fiery flame, its wheels a burning fire)
- [Revelation 1:7-8,12-19](#) (His garment was white as snow, and the hair of His head was like pure wool)
- [Revelation 7:9-17](#) (Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb)
- [2 Corinthians 5:14-21](#) (For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him)
- [Matthew 24:29-31](#) (Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory)

God's Judgment Is In the Earth

- [Hosea 4:1-10](#) (For the Lord brings a charge against the inhabitants of the land: "There is no truth or mercy or knowledge of God in the land)
- [Matthew 3:1-12](#) (Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand)
- [Matthew 23:1-39](#) (Woe to the Scribes and Pharisees)
- [Ezekiel 5:1-16](#) (The sword sent against Jerusalem)
- [Romans 7:13-25](#); [John 1:16-17](#) (The Law cannot save you from sin)
- [Romans 4:13-25](#) (For the promise that he would be the heir of the world was not to Abraham or to his seed through the law, but through the righteousness of faith)
- [John 5:18-30](#) (For the Father judges no one, but has committed all judgment to the Son)
- [John 5:37-47](#) (Life and judgment are through the Son)

In Their Disobedience, They Do Not Listen, Hear, Nor Understand

- [Isaiah 29:9-14](#) (The whole vision has become to you like the words of a book that is sealed, which men deliver to one who is literate, saying, "Read this, please." And he says, "I cannot, for it is sealed)
- [Isaiah 6:9-10](#) (And He said, "Go, and tell this people: 'Keep on hearing, but do not understand; Keep on seeing, but do not perceive)
- [Matthew 13:10-17](#) (I speak to them in parables, because seeing they do not see, and hearing they do not hear, nor do they understand)
- [Acts 28:17-29](#) (So when they did not agree among themselves, they departed after Paul had said one word: "The Holy Spirit spoke rightly through Isaiah the prophet to our

fathers, saying, 'Go to this people and say: "Hearing you will hear, and shall not understand; and seeing you will see, and not perceive)

- [2 Corinthians 4:1-18](#) (But even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing)
- [Revelation 5:1-4](#) (Who is worthy to open the scroll and to loose its seals)
- [Revelation 22:18-19](#) (If anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part from the Book of Life, from the holy city, and *from* the things which are written in this book)
- [Luke 16:19-31](#) (The parable of the rich man and the poor man)

The End Is Not Yet

- [Matthew 24:3-14](#) (Tell us, when will these things be, and what *will be* the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age)
- [Matthew 24:15-22](#) (For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be. And unless those days were shortened, no flesh would be saved; but for the elect's sake those days will be shortened)
- [2 Thessalonians 2:1-11](#) (...for that Day will not come unless the falling away comes first, and the man of sin is revealed, the son of perdition, who opposes and exalts himself above all that is called God or that is worshiped, so that he sits as God in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God)
