## **Bible Study Notes**

### **Isaiah 49: The Servant, the Light to the Gentiles; God Will Remember Zion**

Good morning, welcome to our Sunday morning Bible Study. This morning, we begin our study of Isaiah 49. In this chapter, the Lord is speaking through the prophet Isaiah to deliver a message of warning, of promise, of restoration, of redemption, and of deliverance. He is speaking to all nations and all people.

The Lord our God has declared both His purpose and His will, and all will be accomplished through our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ; the Lamb of God, the last and final sacrifice prepared by our Father and our God. Through Him, God will reconcile all things back to Himself. God has called us all to repentance; our trust, faith, and belief should be in the only true and living God, and in the one whom He sent; that is Jesus Christ our Lord and Savior, the only begotten Son of God.

This was done so that we could all have an opportunity to partake of the salvation which is made available to all through our Rock and our Redeemer. Though He came into the earth as a servant, He is so much more than that; He is the King of Glory, the only Ruler and High Priest over God's people and over God's Kingdom; and there is no other. The topics we will be reading and discussing in this study include:

- The Servant, the Light to the Gentiles (verses 1-13)
- God Will Remember Zion (verse 14-26)

God has not abandoned Israel or Judah, nor has He forgotten about His children, and He never will; even though many of them have forgotten about Him, and no longer recognize or acknowledge His Salvation ([Amos 8:11-12](#), [Isaiah 55:3-11](#)).
